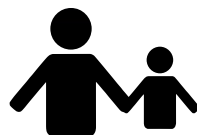

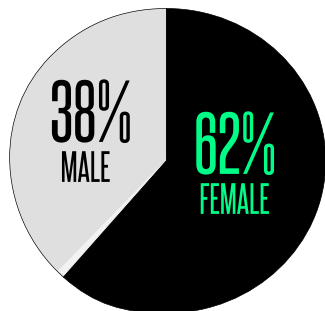

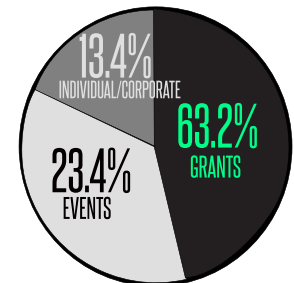
CHILD DEMOGRAPHICS
